SNO-CONE MACHINE OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS

Important Precautions

1. The Sno-Cone Machine can take ice cubes or blocks of ice broken into pieces approximately 3" - 4" in size. The ice will not fit in the shaver if the pieces are too large.
2. The design of the shaving chute automatically draws the ice against the blade. There is no need for manual effort.
3. As a safety feature, the motor will only run while the motor button is depressed.

Operating Instructions

1. Set the cabinet on the drip tray. **Make sure to put the drain hole over a bucket or other area that can accept any draining liquid** from the machine. Melted ice and condensation go into the drip tray.
2. Plug in machine. Turn on power switch (located on front of cabinet). Light will come on in cabinet.
3. Fill the chute to within an inch of the top with ice cubes or block ice. The larger the pieces, the better the snow.
4. Push and **hold** the motor button. Machine will not operate unless you push and hold the red motor button.
5. Wait for the motor to come to full speed.
6. Push the pusher handle down against the ice in the chute. Apply firm and even pressure to make the best snow (too much pressure will result in snow that is coarse; too little pressure will make the snow mushy).
7. Repeat steps 3 - 6 until you have enough shaved ice.
8. Use a ladle or rounded spoon to place snow inside of cone. It may take two scoops to fill cone and leave a rounded top.
9. Add one ounce of syrup and serve.

Cleaning Instructions

1. Unplug machine.
2. Wipe all water and any syrup off of the cabinet inside and out. **DO NOT USE GLASS OR PLASTIC CLEANER THAT CONTAINS AMMONIA.**
3. Clean the Dip Pan.
